IMPORTANT - SCHOLARSHIP RULES:

- Per Master, only one scholarship will be granted per company.
- A company which has already received a scholarship in 2024 for one of its members, is allowed to apply for a new scholarship <u>for another</u> <u>member</u> who wishes to participate in another Cartoon Master 2024, but under no circumstances will have priority over new applicants.
- For all the Cartoon Masters 2024, only one scholarship will be granted per person.
- In any other case, we will select the scholarship holders depending on their motivation and professional profile.
- The applicants must speak English fluently. Speaking the language of the country where the chosen Master is being held would be a plus.
- If the scholarship is accepted, you will have to register online using the specific code that will be sent to you upon the confirmation of your scholarship grant.

Should you want to **apply for scholarship and <u>present a project</u>** at Cartoon Springboard, please send your application form **by 26 July 2024**. The deadline to submit your project online is 2 September.

Should you want to **apply for scholarship** <u>without presenting a project</u> at Cartoon Springboard, please return us your completed scholarship form together with a motivation letter and a CV **by 26 July 2024**.

If you wish to withdraw your scholarship application for young talents with projects at Cartoon Springboard, please confirm by no later than 23 September 2024.

If you wish to withdraw your scholarship application for young talents without projects at Cartoon Springboard, please confirm by no later than 10 September 2024.

Attention: Scholarship candidates requiring a Schengen VISA must inform CARTOON of their VISA approval before the end of September 2024. Any changes after this date will result in room cancellations and administration fees.
