- For all the Cartoon Masters 2025 (CartoonNext / Cartoon Springboard / Cartoon Business), only one scholarship will be granted per person.
- We will select the scholarship holders depending on their motivation and professional profile.
- The applicants must speak English fluently. Speaking the language of the country where the chosen Master is being held would be a plus.
- If the scholarship is accepted, you will have to register online using a specific code that will be sent to you upon the confirmation of your scholarship grant.

If you wish to withdraw your scholarship application for young talents without projects at Cartoon Springboard, please confirm by no later than 5 September 2025.

Attention: Scholarship candidates requiring a Schengen VISA must inform CARTOON of their VISA approval before the end of September 2025. Any changes after this date will result in room cancellations and administration fees.
